**AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE GENEALOGY COMMITTEE AND THEIR DUTIES FOR THE CITY OF PACIFIC, COUNTIES OF FRANKLIN AND ST. LOUIS, STATE OF MISSOURI.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC, MISSOURI, to wit:**

**Section One:** There is hereby created in and for the City of Pacific, The Genealogy Committee for the general supervision and control of the City's genealogy committee.

**Section Two:** There shall be two (2) membership classifications, General and Directors.

**Section Three:** General membership shall be open to the public.

**Section Four:** The Mayor, by and with the consent of the Board of Aldermen, shall appoint the Directors of the Genealogy Committee.

**Section Five:** The Genealogy Committee shall consist of seven (7) Directors, chosen as follows:

- A. Four (4) Directors shall be chosen from the citizens of the City with reference to their fitness for such office.
- B. Two (2) non-resident persons with special interest in Genealogy may serve as regular members of the Genealogy Committee.
- C. One (1) Alderman Representative, appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Board of Aldermen, shall serve as one of the seven directors of the Genealogy Committee.

**Section Six:** The Genealogy Committee Directors shall hold office, two (2) for one year, two (2) for two years, two (2) for three years from the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day in January 2012; and annually thereafter the Mayor shall at the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) Board of Aldermen in May of each year, appoint, as before, two (2) Directors for three (3) years and until their successors are appointed. The Aldermen Representative shall be appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Board of Aldermen on a yearly basis occurring at the (2<sup>nd</sup>) meeting in May.

**Section Seven:** The Mayor may, by and with the consent of the board of Aldermen, remove any Directors of the Genealogy Committee for misconduct or neglect of duty.

**Section Eight:** Vacancies in the Genealogy Committee Board of Directors occasioned by removal, resignation or otherwise shall be reported to the Board of Aldermen and be filled in like manner as original appointments.

**Section Nine:** The Genealogy Members or Directors shall not receive compensation for their services as such.

**Section Ten:** The genealogy Committee shall, immediately after their appointment, meet and organize by the election of (1) of their Directors as President, one (10 of their Directors as Vice President, one (10 of their Directors as Secretary and one (1) of their directors as Treasurer. The Aldermen Representative shall not serve as an officer of the Genealogy Committee.

**Section Eleven:** The Directors of the Genealogy Committee shall make and adopt such by-laws, rules and regulations as approved by the Board of Aldermen, for their guidance and for the Government of the Genealogy Committee as may be expedient and not inconsistent with the terms, provisions, and spirit of this Chapter.

**Section Twelve:** All of the powers and duties of the Genealogy Committee whether mentioned specifically herein or not, shall be subject to the supervision, control and consent of the Board of Aldermen.

**Section Thirteen:** All monies received as donations or gifts for the Genealogy Committee shall be deposited in the city Treasury to the credit of the "Genealogy Fund" and shall be kept separate and apart from the other monies of the City and drawn upon only by the proper officers of the city, upon the properly authenticated vouchers of the Board of Aldermen.

**Section Fourteen:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as they conflict and this this Ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after the day of its passage, the public interest so required.
