AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE IV OF CHAPTER 365 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC TO ELIMINATE CERTAIN TIME-LIMIT RESTRICTIONS ON UNION STREET THAT CONFLICT WITH THE PROHIBITION OF PARKING ON UNION STREET CONTAINED IN SCHEDULE III.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 1381, codified in Chapter 365, Section IV, entitled "Parking Limited or Restricted," the City enacted certain time-limit parking restrictions on the north side of Union Street; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 365, Schedule III, entitled "Parking Prohibited At Any Time," prohibits parking on either side of Union Street west of its intersection with Viaduct; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1381, as codified in Chapter 365, Section IV, conflicts with Chapter 365, Schedule III; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen finds that Chapter 365, Schedule III shall remain in effect and desires to repeal the time-limit restrictions on the north side of Union Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Schedule IV of the Chapter 365 is hereby amended by repealing the following time-limit restriction on Union Street:

SCHEDULE IV. PARKING LIMITED OR RESTRICTED

<i>Ord. No.</i>	<i>Location</i>	<i>Restrictions</i>
1381	On the north side of Union Street between a point commencing 158 feet west of its intersection with Viaduct Street and continuing west for approximately 100 feet to the end of the public right of way in the City of Pacific so that the angle made by the side of the vehicle shall closely approximate (30°) as compared to the curb line.	No Parking for more than two (2) hours between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. on Monday through Friday, except holidays.

The codifier is hereby authorized and directed to delete from Schedule IV of Chapter 365 the above time-limit restriction on Union Street.

Section Two. Ordinance No. 1381 setting the time-limits for parking on the north side of Union Street is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section Three. Except as specifically amended herein, Chapter 365, and specifically Schedule IV, of the Municipal Code of the City of Pacific shall remain in full force and effect. Nothing herein shall preclude enforcement of any other ordinance as may also apply to existing parking regulations or signage all of which shall be supplementary and independent provisions.

Section Four. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

This Bill was passed and approved this 2nd day of April, 2013 by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Pacific, Missouri, after having been read by title or in full two (2) times prior to passage.
