

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-63

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THAT COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT AVAILABLE IN ST. LOUIS COUNTY ALSO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE CITY OF PACIFIC.

Whereas, the voters of St. Louis County passed Proposition E-911 in November 2009; and

Whereas, the tax is collected at businesses in the City of Pacific; and

Whereas, the City of Pacific lies partially in St. Louis County; with an Interstate Highway of 55,000 vehicles per day, two rail lines (92 trains per day) and the Missouri Eastern Correctional Center, (population of 1,100 Inmates) are in the St. Louis County portion of the city; and

Whereas, the E-911 funding has already been used to place an Emergency Warning Siren in the city of Pacific, and equipment will be Provided for the Meramec Ambulance District and the Pacific Fire District;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

The Board of Aldermen hereby request that communication equipment be made available to the City of Pacific in the same manner as all other municipalities in St. Louis County.

This Resolution shall be effective upon passage and approval.
