

**CEMETERY COMMITTEE
RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS
March 22, 2012**

The Cemetery Committee meeting was called to order by President Ruth Muehler on Thursday, March 22, 2012 at 1:30 p.m. Those in attendance were as follows:

Approval of Minutes

The minutes from the February 23, 2012 were presented for approval. Motion made by Jeanne Groth, seconded by Edith McLaren to approve the minutes with a correction on the 2nd page, 2nd paragraph, the name of “Tom Grimm should be changed to Tom Wolf”. Committee members agreed and the motion approved.

Public Requests

Bob Myers stated somebody asked him about putting rock at the top of the hill, and Commissioner Boedges has done that.

President Muehler stated Marilyn Lohneis lives in the east condo on the north side that faces east, the window wells fill up with water when it rains that is runoff from the cemetery. Alderman Gass stated the people that live there filled in the swale and installed 4”- 6” pipe and it has been filled in also. He continued that the people hired someone to do that, there is nothing the city can do, but he suggested she contact the Board of Trustee’s.

Committee Reports & Unfinished Business

Bob Myers stated that he told Barbara Alt to talk to Sexton Alan Bruns about what she wanted done at the cemetery. Sexton Bruns stated he spoke to Administrator Selby about this, and the city approved the idea. Mrs. Alt would like to extend the wall next to the existing wall to the north lot, she wants it raised high enough so the water don’t run through that area and wash out. Alan is going to raise it 6” on the west end and everything else will stay at ground level. The water will flow down the hill, and this will make it look like one lot and be better. He continued he only does that at the request of the owner.

Unfinished

Sexton Alan Bruns had pictures of what he has done with the stones at the Grimm property. He has put a foundation under the stones and protected the graves, at no charge. There is not a sign on the property yet stating this is the Grimm cemetery.

King Adams - Sexton Bruns stated he has had three family members approach him and they do not want the monument installed at Resurrection Hill. They also wished to remain anonymous. Sexton Bruns would like to talk to Mayor Adams about this.

New Business

President Muehler stated that today in the Current Newspaper there is an article about the cemetery and the lawsuits with the City. City Clerk Barfield read the article of the March 2012 edition.

Nettie Painter stated she was still working with Sexton Bruns regarding Lot 24 in Resurrection Hill.
