**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-04 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING OF A

SUBDIVISION SNOW PLOWING SERVICES.**

Mayor Palmore asked for a motion to read Resolution No. 2016-04. **Motion made by Alderman Gass, seconded by Alderman Pigg to read Resolution No. 2016-04.** Mayor Palmore asked for any discussion. Alderman Pigg stated he thought everybody needed to go drive

through the subdivision and look at the streets up there. He thought that we owed the residents a public apology and this could have been handled more professionally.

Mayor Palmore stated he was not going to do that, the people who deserved an apology was the citizens that those funds got taken away from. He apologized for previous administration taking those resources of the city and doing something illegal with them.

Alderman Pigg stated it was not those residents fault that live there now. Mayor Palmore stated he handled it and did it legally. The residents needed to pay for the services that they should have paid for all along. If the Board was to accept those roads, then they need to accept all the subdivisions that are in the process. Alderman Pigg stated the residents in Forest Glen were the innocent victims. The developer and administration handled this wrong. Mayor Palmore stated on January 26th the developer knew of this problem and chose to do nothing about it. Alderman Gass asked who would do the billing for this. Mayor Palmore stated he figured it would happen like the other subdivisions and the City Clerk would do it. City Clerk Barfield stated the association receives the billing.

Alderman Johnson asked why the problem was just identified. Mayor Palmore stated that she was here, why did she say anything about this. How would he know that an illegal agreement was made, this is ridiculous. Alderman Johnson stated this was being corrected now. Mayor Palmore asked who the board members were that approved the steeper grade of street than is allowed. Alderman Gass stated that was the only grade they could get.

A voice vote was taken with an affirmative result. As posted pursuant to the ordinance, City Clerk Barfield read Resolution No. 2016-04.
