**Request for Proposals
Video Security Monitoring
of City of Pacific park properties**

The City of Pacific, Missouri is requesting proposals from qualified vendors and firms interested in providing video security equipment and technology to monitor and protect certain locations in the City of Pacific park properties. The contemplated system will be capable of 24 / 7 monitoring activity at multiple park locations, and will be controlled and monitored from the Pacific Police Communications center. The system must be capable of recording and storing video files for retrieval and use by the Pacific Police Department and other law enforcement agencies.

The City intends to install the selected video security technology at the following park locations:

Park	Location
Jensen Point	Gazebo / Overlook area
Blackburn Park	Civil War cannon / overlook area
Adam's Garden	Flagpole / monument area
Liberty Field Park	New bathroom location
Main City Park	Swimming pool building, Rulon and Burns pavilions; Three bathroom locations, Tennis Courts

The City may at its option elect to install technology at certain priority locations with the initial purchase, and add further locations later.

The intent of this request is to invite vendors and firm to submit proposals which meet the City's broad objective of providing video security monitoring at the selected park locations. The City is open to a variety of technologies and equipment, and intends to select the vendor who can provide the system that best meets the City's unique needs, at the best value.

Content of Proposal

Proposals should include sufficient information for the City to thoroughly evaluate the vendor's proposed products and services. Proposal should include, at minimum, the following information:

1. Description of proposed video security technologies and equipment, including computer hardware and software systems that may be necessary to support the equipment, and

file storage and retrieval functionality. Description of equipment resolution, scanning and coverage area capabilities, power needs and related items should also be included.

2. Description of the firm's product support and maintenance capabilities.
3. A listing of the firm's past projects, with references. Projects that address video security needs at City park or other outdoor locations are preferred.
4. Description of the hardware and software required, if applicable, to enable video monitoring at the Police Communications Center.
5. A detailed cost proposal, including the following:
 - Unit pricing cost of hard equipment and technologies to be deployed at the park locations
 - Costs of software systems necessary to support the equipment
 - Costs of maintenance and support agreements, if applicable
 - Costs to install the equipment at park locations as requested
 - Costs of training, if applicable

Please note that the cost proposal shall not be considered a firm bid, but shall be the basis of a contract to be negotiated between the City and the selected vendor.

All proposals must be received at the Office of City Administrator, 300 Hoven Drive, Pacific MO 63069, no later than 4 p.m. December 21, 2017. Proposals may be delivered electronically (pdf files only please) to Steve Roth, City Administrator, sroth@pacificmissouri.com. Proposals will be made publicly available after the deadline.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive any informalities, and to negotiate directly with any respondent.
