Request for Bids Pedestrian Handrail Jensen Point Park

The City of Pacific, Missouri is requesting bids for construction of a pedestrian handrail at historic Jensen Point Park in the City of Pacific. The successful contractor will be responsible for construction and installation of approximately 220 linear feet of handrail along the stone steps leading up to the park pavilion and overlook area.

Jensen Point Park, an historic Route 66 landmark, was constructed in the 1930's by the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC). The City of Pacific acquired the park in 2014 and has been making repairs and improvements since that time.

The general scope of work is as follows:

Construction and installation of 220 linear feet of 3 ft tall post mounted hand railing composed of 1-3/4" wide molded cap over inverted 1/2" x 1" channel as top hand rail side mounted with a round bar bracket to 1-1/2" heavy wall square tube posts with short pyramidal post caps.

Minor deviations from this specification and / or alternate proposals for handrail construction may be considered by the City. All proposals must meet applicable code requirements for handrail construction.

Bidders must use the accompanying bid form to make your bid. Sealed bids must be RECEIVED at the Office of City Clerk, 300 Hoven Drive, Pacific, Missouri 63069 no later than 2 p.m. November 6, 2017. Please mark "Jensen Point handrail" on the bid envelope. Bids will be publicly opened and read immediately thereafter.

Bids that are submitted after the 2 p.m. deadline will be rejected and will be returned unopened. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities, and to negotiate directly with any respondent.

Bidders are further notified of the following contract requirements:

1. **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.** The successful contractor must provide a Certificate of Insurance explicitly naming the City as Additional Insured, and the Additional Insured status must be endorsed. Contractor shall be required to maintain General Liability Insurance in an amount no less than \$1 million per occurrence, \$2 million in the aggregate; Automobile Liability Insurance in an amount no less than \$1 million, combined single limit; and Worker's Compensation and Employers Liability Insurance, statutory limits. Contractor shall be required to maintain insurance throughout the performance of this contract.
2. **HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT.** The successful contractor shall be required to enter into a Hold Harmless and Indemnification agreement with the City in substantially the following form:
 - a. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City, its officers, agents, volunteers and employees from and against all suits, claims, damages, losses and expenses, including but not limited to attorneys' fees, court costs, or alternative dispute resolution costs arising out of or related to any such suit, claim, damage, loss or expense involving an injury to a person or persons, whether bodily injury or other personal injury (including death), or involving an injury or damage to property (including loss of use or diminution in value), but only to the extent that such suits, claims, damages, losses or expenses were caused by the negligence or other wrongdoing of Contractor, or of any supplier or contractor, or their agents or employees, directly or indirectly, regardless of whether caused in part by the negligence or wrongdoing of City or any of its agents or employees.
3. **BUSINESS LICENSE.** The successful contractor must possess or obtain a City of Pacific business license.
4. **EMPLOYMENT OF UNAUTHORIZED ALIENS.** Pursuant to Section 285.530, RSMo, as a condition of the award of any contract in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), the successful bidder shall, by sworn affidavit and provision of documentation, affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection to the contracted services. Successful bidders shall also sign an affidavit affirming that it does not knowingly employ any person who is an unauthorized alien in connection to the contracted services.

In addition to price, the City will consider the following in determining the bid that is most advantageous to the City:

- a. The ability, capacity and skill of the bidder to perform the contract or provide the goods or service required.
- b. Whether the bidder can perform the contract or provide the goods or service promptly, or within the time specified, without delay or interference.
- c. The character, integrity, reputation, judgment, experience and efficiency of the bidder.
- d. The quality of performance of previous contracts, goods or services.
- e. The previous and existing compliance with the bidder with laws and ordinances relating to the contract, goods or service.

f. The sufficiency of the financial resources and ability of the bidder to perform the contract or provide the goods or service.

g. The quality, availability and adaptability of the supplies, or contractual services to the particular use required.

h. The ability of the bidder to provide future maintenance and service for the use of the subject of the contract.

i. The number and scope of conditions attached to the bid.
