

CITY OF PACIFIC – 2017 FLOOD INFORMATION

UTILITIES – GAS AND ELECTRIC

- For gas and electric reconnections, contact the City Building Department, 636-271-0500 x215
- Staff will take contact information and the building department will contact you to coordinate an inspection before power/gas will be restored.
 - Residents will be required to meet an inspector on site for the inspection to take place
 - Inspector will bring application to you for signature at time of inspection

TRASH REMOVAL - TRASH AND SANDBAGS

TRASH

- All building materials and trash should be moved to the curb in front of your structure, including commercial properties.
- You must be in the flood affected area and have flooding inside your building to qualify for debris removal
- The City in conjunction with the National Guard will be picking up trash from the curb and placing in dumpsters
- Dumpsters will be placed throughout the flood affected area
- DO NOT mix sand bags with trash at the curb.
- DO NOT place hazardous materials out to curb

SANDBAGS

- Sandbags may be placed at the curb but MUST be separate from trash
- DO NOT PUT SANDBAGS IN DUMPSTERS
- Sandbags will be collected by City crews in conjunction with others and hauled off separately from trash.

NOTES ON TRASH REMOVAL

- Large debris from river will be moved by City, call the building department at 636-271-0500 x215 for river debris removal
- Please limit trash to building materials and contents of flooded properties only

ACCESS TO FLOOD AFFECTED AREA

- As of 1:00 PM Thursday 5/4/2017 access to the flood affected area will not be restricted
- There will not be a curfew enforced at night

- Pacific Police Department will be on roving patrols throughout the day and night for your safety and the safety of your property
- The National Guard will be on stationary patrol at various points throughout the city for your safety and the safety of your property

PERMANENT OCCUPANCY TO FLOOD AFFECTED PROPERTIES

- The City must perform Substantial Damage Estimates (SDE) (Inspections) on each flood affected property in the mapped 100-yr floodplain
- NO PERMANENT OCCUPANCY will be issued until the SDE is completed
- There will be crews of inspectors moving throughout the flood affected area to get SDE's completed as quickly as possible
- These inspections will not be scheduled but the City will make contact with the resident(s) or owner before inspection is completed

HIGHWAY O/F (FIRST STREET)

- Highway O is open as of 1:00 PM 5/4/2017. Under the current forecast Highway O should remain open during the second crest, but conditions may change.

PRECAUTIONARY BOIL ADVISORY

- The Boil Advisory has been lifted as of 11:00 am Thursday May 4, 2017
- A notification went out via the electronic phone messaging system at the time the advisory was lifted

BUILDING PERMITS

- In order to do any remodeling to a building, you must obtain a building permit from the City of Pacific
- Applications can be picked up at City Hall – 300 Hoven Drive Pacific, MO
- Applications can be found online at pacificmissouri.com. Click on "Administration" tab and then "Forms" then "Permit Application"

NATIONAL GUARD

- The National Guard is here to assist in cleanup as well as to keep watch over property
- National Guard units will also be assisting in cleanup of trash and debris

PROPERTIES NOT IN THE CITY LIMITS

- If your property is not in the City limits of Pacific we do not regulate your utilities or building permits.
