

Major Improvements for 2014

The City is pleased to announce several major improvement projects for the coming year. Starting as early as January you will see construction begin on projects throughout Pacific. All of the projects are designed in an effort to improve safety, system maintenance, and appearance as well as connecting all Pacific residents with sidewalks.

The first major project, starting this winter, will be the replacement of water main and water services along Congress between Hawthorne Subdivision and the City Park. The new water main will be located outside the pavement on Congress to improve ease of maintenance. The new eight inch main will be larger providing better flow and circulation throughout the area.

The next project scheduled to start in early spring is the East Osage Improvements. This project will include curb and gutter, sidewalks, and street lights from seventh street east all the way to the Red Cedar Inn. Again, this will provide aesthetic enhancements as well as better access to the east side of town.

Thornton Road is another much anticipated project that will happen early in 2014. This project includes curb and gutter, sidewalks, street lighting, and resurfacing of Thornton from Viaduct to Eagle's View Subdivision.

We are finalizing the design on two other major roadway improvements with construction slated for later in 2014. These projects are Congress Street and Old Gray Summit Road. The Congress Street project will be in conjunction with the water main improvements from Hawthorne to Fourth St. including sidewalks, curb and gutter, and resurfacing of Congress. This project will extend the improvements made last year along Congress between Hawthorne and Riverbend School.

Last but not least, the Old Gray Summit improvements will include curb and gutter, storm sewer improvements and resurfacing between Congress (Hwy N) and Sierra Ridge at the western city limits. The completion of this project will leave Old Gray Summit Road with curb and gutter on both sides of the road for its entire length in the city as well as sidewalk on at least one side for its entire length.

Most of these projects are being constructed with federal grants that provide Pacific with the ability to make excellent, cost friendly improvements. We are excited to see these projects completed and hope you are too!
