The City of Pacific will hold a public hearing on November 17, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall to discuss an application to be submitted to the Missouri Department of Economic Development under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. The city is interested in obtaining citizen input on community and economic development needs within the City. The maximum amount of funds available from the CDBG program depends upon the type of project, but cannot exceed \$ 1,500,000 for economic development \$ 300,000 for public facilities projects, or \$ 500,000 for neighborhood development projects. The City proposes to request approximately \$ 750,000 in CDBG funds for an infrastructure grant to assist in the construction of public infrastructure to support industrial development in the City of Pacific.
